SUPERVISION OF PROFESSIONAL STAFF

Classroom visits are for several purposes: to encourage the growth and exchange of new ideas in teaching techniques and use of materials, to discover ways and means of coordinating the curriculum, to observe pupil conduct and pupil progress, to keep the administration informed about what is going on in the school program, and to evaluate effectiveness, particularly as a basis for recommendation for the re-appointment of all staff.

Conferences between the principal/supervisor and the professional shall be held to promote the above purposes. Some conferences shall be formal and result in a written record. Informal conferences may occur frequently and may be summarized in the written record of the formal conference in accordance with the teacher evaluation master plan.
